### A Discussion of the Tucannon River Steelhead Fishery

Fisheries Program Manager Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife

Joe will provide an update on the status of the fishery, including of returns and harvest management.

Joe started with Washington Department of Fish & Wildlife in 1993 in the Southeast Washington Region, primarily monitoring Tucannon River Spring Chinook. Between 2000 and 2013, he tracked and estimated hatchery and wild steelhead returns to Southeast Washington as part of the yearly monitoring that occurs under the Lower Snake River Compensation Plan (LCSRP). Currently, Joe is the Project Leader for Hatchery Evaluations under the LSCRP for Washington.


